College Football Stadiums Instructions



Make your own bucket list map of all the college football stadiums that you or a loved one has visited. This includes all of the conferences, and the teams that are included.

KIT INCLUDES:

- » 2 pages of 12"x12" black vinyl, pre-cut US states and text
- » 2 pages of 12"x12" vinyl transfer tape
- » 12 ziplock baggies of NCAAF logos, separated into conferences
- » 1 package of tacks, .375" diameter









Attaching Vinyl to Corkboard

YOU WILL NEED:

- » Corkboard, 23"x17" or larger
- » Scissors
- 1. Attach the provided Vinyl Transfer Tape to surface of states. Burnish with a flat tool so that the states are attached to the transfer tape.
- 2. Lift off transfer tape and states, so that no states remain attached to the shiny base layer.
- 3. Line up the states on the **corkboard**, allowing for space for the states on the right-half to be added later.
- 4. While transfer tape is still attached, burnish the states onto the corkboard so they are firmly attached. Remove transfer tape by pulling at a sharp angle.
- 5. Repeat steps for the right-hand side of the US. Use **scissors** to separate the text from the states for ease of application.
- 6. NOTE: It is best to do the states first, and then line up the text in the desired locations afterward. For an example of the finished product, refer to the image on the first page of these instructions.

Adding Logos to Thumb Tacks

YOU WILL NEED:

» Mod Podge, or other clear adhesive

- 1. Remove any logo from one of the provided baggies.
- 2. Apply **mod podge** to the back of the logo, and attach to one of the provided thumb tacks. Since the thumb tack is curved, press the logo around the edge so that it follows along the curve.
- 3. Add to corkboard and allow to dry.
- 4. Repeat with the remaining logos, adding them to the corkboard in their designated conferences. For an example of the finished product, refer to the image on the first page of these instructions.
